# West End Sidewalk Renewals McGibbon Drive – Davis Avenue to Katimavik Road Contract No. ISD16-7120

#### **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE**

August 2017

Dear Resident,

In mid-August the City of Ottawa will begin construction work in your neighbourhood. This work is being conducted to improve the sidewalks in your community.

**Who:** The Contractor, Ottawa D Squared Construction Ltd., will be performing the construction

work for the City of Ottawa.

**Why:** Due to the age and condition of the existing sidewalks, the City of Ottawa will be

proceeding with their replacement.

**What:** Work will involve the removal of existing sidewalks and construction of new sidewalks.

During the construction there may be temporary lane reductions and parking restrictions

along McGibbon Drive in the vicinity of the work to take place.

When: This work is planned to begin in mid-August. Completion is anticipated by the end of

September.

Where: McGibbon Drive between Davis Avenue and Katimavik Road.

#### **Accessibility**

Accessibility is an important consideration for the City of Ottawa. The City makes every effort to provide access through and around construction sites. If you require special accommodation, please contact the Contractor's Representative or the City's Project Manager noted below.

#### **Construction Disruptions**

The Contractor will take every precaution to minimize interruptions to the everyday life of your family and/or operation of your business, but, as you can appreciate, there may be some inconvenience during the course of the work, such as traffic delays, parking restrictions, and noise. We would like to thank you for your patience and co-operation.

#### Impact on the Right-of-Way and Adjacent Private Properties

The reconstruction is within the City's right-of-way but may result in some disruption to part of the private property directly adjacent to the work. Lawns, pathways, gardens and/or driveways may be disturbed. The affected areas will be reinstated as soon as possible after construction is completed, at no cost to you. However, if you have plants or any other assets located within the City's right-of-way that you want to preserve, we suggest that you may want to move the plants in preparation for the construction work.
